Dear Mr. Claunch:

On Jan. 3rd., 1945 I rented to you my farm consisting of about 67 acres for the year 1945, and had a contract drawn in order that both of us would not have any misunderstanding. This contract specifically provided that you were not at any time to pasture the alfalfa meadow. Any one knows this is hard on the meadow, and I wanted this matter clearly understood. For the past few days I have noticed cows and horses running on the alfalfa meadow. I call your attention to the contract of which you have a copy. In event you have lost your copy I will gladly furnish you mine for reference. I had hoped that we would not have any trouble, and we will not at this time if you will abide to the contract.
