The plaintiff, the Commonwealth of Kentucky by ~~M. P. Rehorn~~ *R. J. O'Mahony*, duly appointed, qualified and acting
Revenue Agent for the State at Large, states that the defendant, State Bank & Trust
Company, Executor of the estate of George W. Robinson, deceased.

was, on the first day of September, 1900, 1901, 1902 and 1903, a resident of
Mercer County, Kentucky, and that on each of the aforesaid dates the said
defendant was the owner of personal property as follows, to-wit:

On September 1, 1910 Cash and notes, secured and unsecured, mortgage
bonds and other personal property

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 5000.00

On September 1, 1911, cash, notes, secured and unsecured, mortgage bonds
and other personal property

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00

On September 1, 1912, cash, notes secured and unsecured, mortgage bonds
and other personal property

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00

On September 1, 1913 Cash notes secured and unsecured
mortgage bonds and other personal property

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 6000.00

On September 1, 1914

and all of said property being of the fair cash value of \$ 2300.00

all of which property was wholly omitted from assessment for taxation for State and County purposes with
the Assessor of Mercer County or any other assessing officer or assessing board of
said County or of the State of Kentucky, on each of the dates aforesaid, and that the tax thereon is now
delinquent.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff prays judgment that said property be assessed against the defendant herein,
State Bank & Trust Company, Executor of George W. Robinson as of each of the dates
aforesaid at the valuations named and that he be adjudged liable to the Commonwealth of Kentucky and
Mercer County for the tax on said property for the years 1900, 1901,

1902, 1903, together with a penalty of twenty (20%) per centum thereon due the Revenue
Agent, M. P. Rehorn, instituting this action. Plaintiff prays for its costs herein expended and for all
further and proper relief.
