

BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant, Howard McCoun, being in custody

being admitted to bail in the sum of One Hundred Dollars

THEREFORE, we Howard McCoun Principal
and N. I. Buxton Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky
do hereby undertake that the above named Howard McCoun
shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 24

day of August, 1918, to answer to said charge, and shall at all times
render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the
prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execu-
tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that
we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of 100.00
Dollars.
