He states that this is an action for the recovery of money; that the defendant is about to sell, convey and otherwise dispose of his property for the purpose of cheating, hindering and delaying his creditors including this plaintiff.

Wherefore he prays for a judgment against the defendant in the sum of \$46.55 with interest thereon from this date and for his cost and for a general order of attachment against the property of this defendant. He prays for all proper relief.
