The plaintiff E.V.Seay states that he is a regular graduated, practicing physician practicing in Mercer County, Kentucky and adjoining counties; he says that the defendant Will Goodlet is indebted to him in the sum of \$ 26,50 for medical services rendered by this plaintiff at the defendants special instance and request and for which he promised and agreed to pay; he says that said claim is just due and unpaid and that he has demanded payment of same and that he believes that he should recover from the said defendant the above named amount with interest and costs.
