

BAIL BOND.

THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, MERCER COUNTY COURT.

The Defendant H.P. Bunch being in custody
of the Sheriff of Mercer County, charged with the offense
of failure to send his children to school and
being admitted to bail in the sum of fifty Dollars:

THEREFORE, we H.P. Bunch Principal

and H.P. Bunch Surety, of Mercer County, Kentucky,

do hereby undertake that the above named H.P. Bunch

shall appear in the Mercer County Court, on the 9th

day of October 1920, to answer said charge, and shall at all times
render himself amenable to the order and process of said Court in the
prosecution of said charge, and if convicted shall render himself in execu-
tion thereof; or if he shall fail to perform either of these conditions, that

we will pay to the Commonwealth of Kentucky the sum of Five
Dollars.
