The plaintiff Ft Harrod Implement Company states that it
is a partnership composed of G L Johnson and Walter Martin,

That on the 7th day of Apr 1926, the defendants by their
promissory note which they executed and delivered to the plaintiffs
in which they agreed and promised to pay to the plaintiff Sept 1st/26
after date, the sum of \$56.00 with interest thereon from date,
no part of which has ever been paid. Said note is filed herewith.

It states that the said note was executed and delivered to
the plaintiff in consideration of its sale to the defendants of one
disk harrow and by said agreement and contract that the ownership
of the said harrow remained in the plaintiff until the note was fully
paid, and that neither ownership nor possession thereof passed to
the defendants until said payment.

Wherefore they pray judgment against the defendants for
the said sum of \$56. with interest thereon from date and for ~~a~~
~~generally~~ an order of delivery of said harrow to the plaintiff.
It says that the defendants and neither of them has any property
subject to execution and that the collection of plaintiff's demand
will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment and a return of
no property found. That their claim is just and that it ought to
recover the sum of \$56. as aforesaid with interest from Apr 7th 1926
They pray for their cost and all proper relief.
