1. The Plaintiff, R. A. Wilham states that on ~~the~~ June 21, 1919 he became deft's surety to Farmers Bank of Salvisa, Ky for a note of that date due in six months amounting to \$52.00; that when said note became due that this plaintiff paid thereon as surety on Dec. 23, 1919 the sum of \$2.00 interest and said note was renewed, as a note dated Dec. 23, 1919 due to same Bank on June 23, 1920 for \$50; that when the latter note fell due the defendant failed to pay it and the plaintiff was compelled to pay it; both of said notes are filed herewith; plaintiff paid on the renewal note \$50 principal and \$6.00 interest.

He states that the defendant is a non-resident of and now absent from Mercer County Kentucky; that he resides at #139 East 55th St. Chicago, Ill Chicago, Illinois where mail will reach him; that the defendant has no property in this state subject to execution to satisfy the indebtedness sued on and the collection thereof will be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment or a return of no property found; that this is an action for money due on said note and contract.

Wherefore he prays judgment for \$2.00 with 6% interest from ~~the~~ Dec 23, 1919, and \$50.00 with 6% interest from Dec 23, 1919 and costs; for a general order of attachment against the defendant and for all proper ~~the~~ relief.
