

Warrant of Arrest

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that Marvin Logue,
Leonard Gaines, ~~Minnie Lee~~ ^{Brunell} Gains, and Lee Yeast,

has committed the offense of
unlawfully, transporting Spiritous, vinous, malt or intoxicating liquors
not for sacramental purposes, the said Leonard Gaines, Minnie Lee
Gains, and Lee Yeast inducing the said Logue in said transporting same
in the County of Mercer, the 15th day of MAY 1932.

You are therefore commanded to arrest said Marvin Logue, Minnie Lee Yeast
Leonard Gaines and Lee Yeast
and bring them before me to be dealt with according to law.
