Def.

The plaintiff, O.L.Sallee, states that the defendant,

John Edwards, is indebted to him in the sum of \$9. 10, for goods and mer-

chandise sold and delivered to the defendant at his special instance

and request and for which he has never paid any part of the purchase

price. He says that the defendant has no property in this state subject

to execution, or not enough thereof to satisfy the plaintiff's claim,

or the claims of the defendant's creditors, and that the collection of

the said demands would be endangered by delay in obtaining judgment

and a return of no property found.

Wherefore he prays judgment against the defendant in

the sum of \$9.10, for all costs expended in this action, and for all

proper relief, including a general order of attachment against the

property of the defendant and that The D.T. Bohon Co., be summoned as gar-

nishes. He prays for all relief.
