The plaintiff's W.A.Tribble, C.O.Pickett and James B.Tribble, state that they are partners doing business under the firm name of the Tribble Pickett Furniture Company, at Danville, Ky., they state that the defendant on the 13th day of Nov. 1919, executed and delivered his promissory note, to the L.B.Sapp Furniture Company, of Danville, Ky., for the sum \$ 393.10, by which he agreed to pay the said L.B.Sapp Furniture Co. said sum in monthly installments of \$ 25.00 per month until said sum was fully paid and satisfied; plaintiff, states that the firm of Tribble ,Pickett and Company, are the successors, of the firm of the L.B.Sapp Furniture Company, having purchased the stock of goods, accounts and notes from the said L.B.Sapp Furniture Company, and that the said note of the defendant C.M.Wright, was for value received transferred and assigned to this plaintiff and that they are now the owner and holder of said note of indebtedness against the defendant; they state that the defendant has paid on said note the sum of \$ 266.00, leaving a balance now due and owing by the defendant to this plaintiff of \$ 127.10, no part of which has been paid.

Wherefore and etc. Plaintiff states that to secure the payment of the said \$ 393.10 nthat the said defendant executed and deliver to the L.B.
