The plaintiff, C.R.Caldwell, states that on the 11th day of June 1920, the defendants, George A. Stratton and J.L.Stratton, executed and delivered to ~~him~~ him their certain promissory note for the sum of \$63.09 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% from date until paid and on the 6th day of December 1920 there was paid on this note the sum of \$18.38. That there has been no other payments made on said note and the balance thereof with 6% interest from said date is still due and owing and unpaid and payment has been repeatedly demanded but refused, said note coming due in 6 months from date.

Plaintiff says that defendants have no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof satisfy plaintiff demand and that the collection of the said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same and that this is an action for money due upon a contract.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment against the defendants in the sum of \$63.09 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% from date <sup>June 11-1920</sup> until paid subject to a credit of \$18.38 made on the 6th day of December 1920, and all the costs of this action and for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and
