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Comes Garnishee and states that on February 5, 1924 Albert Cinnaman, whose address is Salvisa, Kentucky Route #1, delivered to it 3020 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop for which was issued participation certificate #135985.

On February 9, 1924 said Albert Cinnaman delivered to Garnishee 125 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop for which was issued participation certificate #136188.

On said dates Garnishee paid the advance on said tobacco as follows:

Said certificates were assigned by R. E. Crossfield to State Bank & Trust Company of Harrodsburg, Kentucky for ALL.

Said tobacco is subject to a mortgage in favor of R. E. Crossfield in the amount of \$1743.50.

There will be further distribution payments on the crop of 1923 tobacco delivered to this Garnishee by its grower members, but the time when such payments will be made or the amount thereof, is unknown to Garnishee.

WHEREFORE, Garnishee prays to be protected in its rights, for its costs herein expended and all proper relief.
