

Cards Received From Prisoners Of Japs

DANVILLE, Ky., Aug. 16 (Special)—Cards have been received from Philippine Military Prison Camp No. 1 by Mrs. Sarah Sallee of Danville from her sons, Pvt. James W. Sallee and Pfc. Heze Franklin Sallee, who left in the fall of 1941 with members of the 192nd Tank Battalion of the Harrodsburg National Guards.

The recent messages from the prison camp state that the young men are in good health and uninjured. One soldier expressed concern for his mother's allotment, the other for his wife and baby.

Heze Sallee has failed to receive letters informing him his child did not survive its birth in December, 1941.
