This cause being submitted on demurrer to each paragraph of Defendant's answer and counterclaim, the court overrules the same, ~~Thereupon Plaintiff~~ to which ruling of the court the Plaintiff excepts. Thereupon Plaintiff filed a reply to which Defendant filed a rejoinder to which Plaintiff filed a demurrer, extending to the whole thereof and to each paragraph separately, and being submitted to the court for judgment thereon, said demurrer is sustained to which the Defendant excepts. Defendant declining to plead further and this cause being then submitted generally for judgment on the pleadings, proof and exhibits filed, the court being advised, is of opinion that Plaintiff is entitled to the relief sought. It is, therefore, adjudged that Plaintiff, O.A. Byington, recover of the Defendant, The Republican Publishing Company, the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) and interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum from January 27, 1915, until paid and his cost herein expended. It is further ordered that Defendant recover nothing on ~~its~~ answer and counterclaim and the same is hereby dismissed.
