ASSOCIATION

PRYOR COFFMAN & T. W. COFFMAN

DEFENDANTS

Cornes Garnishee and states that on December 27th, 1922, Pryor Coffman, whose address is Burgin, Kentucky, delivered to it 2500 pounds of tobacco of the 1922 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #50636.

On the above date Garnishee paid the advance on said tobacco to Pryor Coffman in the sum of \$318.83.

On April 19th, 1923, said certificate was assigned to Citizens Bank & Trust Company, Burgin, Kentucky, for "ALL".

On May 26th, 1923, Garnishee paid the distribution accruing under said certificate to Citizens Bank & Trust Co., in the sum of \$255.06.

On May 20th, 1924, Garnishee paid the distribution accruing under said certificate to Citizens Bank & Trust Co., for \$9.92.

Garnishee states further that on January 18th, 1924, Pryor Coffman, whose address is Burgin, Kentucky, delivered to it 1810 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #135201.

On the latter date Garnishee paid the advance on said tobacco of the 1923 crop as follows:

E. E. Guttry, to apply on landlord's lien	\$48.00
Pryor Coffman	137.63

On January 29th, 1924, participation certificate #135201 was assigned to Citizens Bank & Trust Co., Burgin, Kentucky, for "ALL".

There will be further distribution payments on the 1922 and 1923 crops of tobacco delivered to Garnishee by its grower members, but the date of such payments, or the amount thereof, is unknown to Garnishee.

Garnishee has no record of any crop delivery made by the defendant, T.W. Coffman, and has in its possession no monies due or to become due to the said T.W. Coffman.
