The Plaintiff, Ethel D. Henderson, states that the defendant is a corporation under the laws of the State of Kentucky with power to sue and be sued, to contract and be contracted with, having its principal place of business in Mercer County, Kentucky.

She states that prior to September 15, 1915, ~~she had~~ the defendant employed her as a teacher of music in its College, for the period of time from Sept. 15, 1915 until May 23, 1916, and agreed to pay her for her services the sum of \$600.00, which amount was to be due on or before the expiration of said time; that she taught music for the defendant throughout said time in its college which teaching was accepted by it; that although said sum of \$600.00 is now past due, it has paid her only the sum of \$400.00, leaving due and unpaid the sum of \$200.00..

Wherefore she prays judgment against the defendant for the sum of \$200.00 with 6% interest thereon from May 23, 1916 until paid and her costs and generally for all proper relief.
