The plaintiff, Geo. Bohon Co. states that on the 30th of January, 1914 the defendants, Josephine Woods and Jim Woods, executed and delivered to Geo. Bohon Co. their certain promissory note by the terms of which on the Jan. 1st, 1915 after date, they promised to pay to this plaintiff the sum of \$133.75 with 6% interest thereon from maturity until paid. They state that no part of said note has been paid and the same is filed herewith as a part hereof marked "A" for identity.
