The garnishee defendant, E.M. Hardin states that he is Master Commissioner of the Mercer Circuit Court and as such, had in his hands for distribution, the sum of \$204.00 due to the debt., Jas. Woods, in this case. The debt. states that said James Woods gave to the Geo. Bohon Co. on the 14th of June, 1915 an order directed to him as Master Commissioner, signed by said debt., Jas. Woods, directing him to pay out of the above sum to said Woods the sum of \$133.75 with interest thereon from Jan 1st, 1915. He states that said order was duly signed by said Woods and that said order was presented to him on said date and accepted by him. He states that on the 9th of Aug. 1915, the said Ryley authorized this garnishee defendant to pay to the State Bank & Trust Co. the sum of \$52.00 with interest from Aug. 9th, 1915. The debt. states that he accepted said order and that he has in his hands the difference between the above mentioned debts and interest and \$204.00, due to the plff J.L. Ryley, which he holds subject to the orders of this Court.

Wherefore he prays to be dismissed with his cost and for a direction as to the payment of the residue in his hands.
