

labor and services she has never received one cent from Plaintiff. She says that
said services were rendered at the special instance and request of Plaintiff and
they were reasonably worth \$25.00 per month, or \$125.00 for the entire period of
her labor, no part of which has been paid. She pleads said sum as a counter-claim
against Plaintiff's claim, and prays judgment over against him for the sum of ~~\$100.00~~
\$125.00 and her cost herein expended. She denies that she is indebted in the sum
of \$20.00 or any sum. She denies that she is a non-resident of Kentucky, or that Plaintiff's
claim is just, or that Plaintiff ought to recover of this Defendant the sum
of \$20.00, the cost of the action, or any sum. Affiant further says that she is a bona
fide resident of Mercer County, Ky., with a family consisting of herself and one child,
a girl 5 years old and residing with her;
that her husband is absent by reason of his service in the United States army; that
she has no property here or elsewhere, except the sewing machine attached herein and
a few bed clothes and small household goods, the whole not exceeding \$75.00 in value.
Wherefore, she claims said property as exempt from the attachment herein, and asks
that the same be discharged. She prays for all proper relief.
