This case coming on to be heard and the plaintiff having been duly summoned in this case and failed to make defense, it is ordered that the plaintiff is entitled to the relief sought in their petition and that they recover of the defendant, William Lunsford, the sum of \$39.00, with interest thereon from this date until paid and the costs of this action.

It is further ordered that the grounds of attachment herein be and same are hereby sustained.

It appearing that the Sheriff of Mercer County levied the attachment issued in this case on 300 sticks of tobacco belonging to the defendant herein, which tobacco is now in the barn on the William Devine place in Mercer County, Ky.

It is now ordered and adjudged that John Morgan, Sheriff of Mercer County, Ky sell said tobacco for the purpose of paying the judgment, interest and costs. The said Morgan is directed to make said sale in one of the tobacco ware-houses in Murrrodsburg, Mercer County, Ky on Monday, January 11th, 1918. Before making said sale said Morgan will advertise the ~~in~~ time, place and amount for which said tobacco will be sold by posting hand bills containing a description of the property and the above information. He will sell said tobacco for cash. He will report his acts at the next term of this Court.
