### Services for Death March survivor set for Monday

HARRODSBURG — Services will be held Monday for Maurice E. "Jack" Wilson, a survivor of the Bataan Death March during World War II and a disabled veteran, who died at 7:45 p.m. Thursday at Veterans Administration Hospital, Lexington, after a three-week illness.

Wilson, 73, of 930 Riverside Drive, Harrodsburg, was imprisoned for 3½ years in the Philippines by the Japanese and received a Purple Heart.


He was active in numerous veteran activities and held life memberships in the Disabled American Veterans, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Bataan and Corregidor Survivors and the Ex-Prisoners of War Association.

He had served with the Harrodsburg 192 Tank Battalion, the American Legion, and the "408," an organization associated with the American Legion that originated in France during World War I.

Born March 2, 1912, near McAfee, he was the son of the late Lester and Lula Britton Wilson. He was a member of New Providence Presbyterian Church at McAfee.

Survivors include his wife, Rosalyn Adkinson Wilson; two sisters, Mrs. G.C. (Shannon) Farney of Harrodsburg and Emma Lou Collins of Lexington; and several nieces and nephews.
