Said labor was done at the instance and request of the defendant and is reasonably worth the sum of \$6.50 and that said sum is due and unpaid although payment has been demanded.

The plaintiff further states that the tobacco crop sold for \$155.86 and that one-half of this amount, which is \$77.93, is due the plaintiff for his interest in said crop and that said amount is being illegally and wrongfully held by the defendant and is unpaid although payment has been repeatedly demanded.

The plaintiff further states that the defendant is indebted to him in the sum of \$12.00 for a two-horse wagon sold and delivered by him to the defendant at his special instance and request and for which the defendant promised to pay said amount and that said sum is due and unpaid although payment has been demanded.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays for a ~~judgment~~ full settlement of his account with the defendant and for a judgment against him for a total of said amounts alleged in the petition, which total is \$112.00, and for all other relief, either in law or equity, to which he is, or may appear to be, entitled.
