Comes now the plaintiff, T.J.Miller, and states that at a term of the Mercer Quarterly Court long prior to the issue of the execution herein referred to and made a part hereof, he obtained a judgment against the defendant, Sam Scott, for the sum of \$50.00 with interest thereon from the 12th day of March 1912 and the costs of this action; he says that on the 16th day of June 1925, he had issued by the Judge of the Mercer County Court an execution upon said judgment and that said execution was placed in the hands of the sheriff of Mercer County, S.W.Kennedy, and by him return upon said execution was made as follows, Viz:

"No property found in Mercer County to make any part of the within execution. This June 16, 1925. S.W.Kennedy, S.M.Co." He says that Mercer County is the county in which the judgment was rendered and also the county of the defendant's residence; that said execution is in full force and effect, and is in words and figures as follows: *Mercer* Quarterly Court Execution- The Commonwealth of Ky. To the sheriff or any constable of Mercer County: We command you that of the personal estate of S.R.Scott, you cause to be made the sum of \$50.00 and ----- cents, which T.J.Miller, late in our Court Mercer Quarterly Court hath recovered against him for debt, with interest thereon from the 12th day of March 1912 until paid; also, the sum of \$9.30, which in our Court was adjudged to the said Miller for his costs in that suit expended, whereof the said defendant is convicted, as appears of record; and that you have the said sums of money before our said Court on the 18th day of July 1925 to render to said Miller ~~his said~~ debt, interest and costs aforesaid, and have then & there this writ. Witness my hand as Judge of our said Court this 15th day of June 1925. Ben C.Allin- J.M.Q.C. The Judgment upon which this execution issues was rendered at the January Term, 1925."

Wherefore plaintiff asks for a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant and for a summon against Steve Scott, as executor of the estate of Hence Scott- He prays for all relief-
