Five more men from Mercer county have been liberated from Japanese prisoner of war camps, according to the day's report of Army War casualties, in which no others from this area were listed.

The released servicemen include Private George E. Chumley, son of Mrs. Lola Chumley; Pfc Lawrence I. Martin, son of Mrs. Lillie Martin and Pfc William Peavler, son of Mrs. Omie Peavler, all of Harrodsburg; Staff Sergeant Morris S. Collier, brother of Everett Collier Jr., Rose Hill, and Private Stanley H. Kyler, grandson of Mrs. Martin H. Devine, Cornishville.

Next of kin had received previous notification of the men's release.
