

Plaintiffs aver that they are informed and they believe and aver that the defendant has a demand against L. E. Myer Co., for work and labor done and performed, by said defendant.

Wherefore, plaintiffs now pray that L. E. Myer Company, be summoned to answer as garnishee and be required to answer and pay into court a sufficiency of any sum in their hands, due, owing or belonging to the defendant D. F. Rankin, to satisfy the aforesaid judgment rendered in their favor in the Boyle Quarterly Court for the sum of \$137.80, with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from February 13th. 1924, until paid, and \$7.35, their costs in said court incurred; they pray for their costs in this behalf expended or incurred and for all general, equitable and proper relief to which they may appear entitled.
