The plaintiffs M. C. Helm and M. T. Helm, state that they are and were at the times hereinafter complained of engaged in the business of retail merchants under the firm name and style of M. C. Helm & Son.

Plaintiffs aver that at the March Term, 1924 of the Boyle Quarterly Court the recovered judgment against the defendant, D. F. Rankin, in the sum of \$137.81 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from the 13th. day of February, 1924 until paid. An attested copy of said judgment is filed herewith as a part hereof marked "Exhibit A".

Plaintiffs aver that thereafter on the 19th. day of June 1924 they caused an execution to be issued from the office of the judge of the Boyle Quarterly Court, upon the aforesaid judgment, said execution being directed to the sheriff of Boyle County, the county of the residence of the defendant, directing said sheriff to make of the estate of said defendant the amount of their aforesaid judgment with the costs of the aforesaid action and the costs of issuing said execution; and that same was returned by ther sheriff of Boyle County, Kentucky, endorsed "No property found to satisfy this fifa or any part thereof, this J<sup>u</sup>ne 19th. 1924, W. Logan Wood, Sheriff of Boyle County". A copy of said execution and return thereof is filed herewith as a part hereof marked "Exhibit B".
