The defendant having failed to answer it is adjudged that plaintiff A. B. Teater recover of defendant D. M. Moore \$70.62 with 6% interest therefrom Aug 21, 1918 and costs and the grounds of attachment be sustained.

The Court being advised on the question of the fund in the hands of Mercer National Bank, garnishee, it having answered that it holds \$20.94 Tom Cloyd ~~McGuffin & Cunninham~~ and Dan Brummette having filed claims for ~~\$10~~ and \$1 and \$10 respectively, the court holds that the plaintiff is entitled to a lien on said fund and that Cloyd and Brummette are not entitled to the same. Said garnishee is ordered to pay into Court the sum of \$20.94 to be applied to the satisfaction of the plaintiff's judgment, and execution may issue for the balance remaining unpaid. *Thereupon came Mercer National Bank and paid into Court \$20.94 accordingly.*
