The defendant having failed to answer it is adjudged that plaintiff A. B. Teater recover of defendant D. M. Moore \$70.62 with 6% interest therefrom Aug 21, 1918 and costs and the grounds of attachment be ^{and they are hereby} sustained.

The Court being advised on the question of the fund in the hands of Mercer National Bank, garnishee, it having answered that it holds \$20.94 — Tom Cloyd ~~McGuffin & Dan~~ and Dan Brummette having filed claims for ~~\$10 and~~ \$1 and \$10 respectively, the court holds that the plaintiff is entitled to a lien on said fund and that Cloyd and Brummette are not entitled to the same. ~~The~~ Said garnishee is ordered to pay into Court the sum of \$20.94 to be applied to the satisfaction of the plaintiff's judgment, and execution may issue for the balance remaining unpaid. *Thereupon Came Mercer National Bank and paid into Court \$20.94 accordingly.*
