The land directed to be sold in this action under the judgment therein having been advertized and sold by E. M. Hardin, Master Commissioner, on March 4th, 1912, and ^{me of} the owners of said real property, to-wit, George Roach and ~~David~~ Thompson, having become the purchasers thereof at said sale, report of which has been made to the court by said commissioner, now come the parties plaintiff and defendants to this action and enter the following agreed order herein, viz:

All the money paid in this case for the purpose of satisfying the judgment and the costs herein have been paid ^{equally} by the defendants Roach and Thompson, the payment also including a note to the State Bank and Trust Company of Harrodsburg, Ky., for \$150⁰⁰ ^{and interest}.
