The Plaintiff states that it is a corporation under the laws of Kentucky with power to sue and be sued, to contract and be contracted with to sue and be sued, being incorporated under the Kentucky Laws.

It states that at the special instance and request of the defendant M. D. Stathis who is the same person and Milton Stathis, in the months of December 1915 and Jany 1916 at the times more specifically set out in the attached account which is made a part hereof, and made a part hereof; that said account contains all items furnished the amounts charged therefor and the defendant agreed and promised to pay the amounts charged for said articles, amounting to the sum of \$74.50, on which there has been paid only \$1.00 on March 9, 1917.

It states that said sum is just due and owing; that it believes it should have and recover of the defendant \$74.50 with 6% interest from Feby 1, 1916 and costs subject to credit of \$1.00 paid March 9, 1917; that this is an action for money due on the contract and obligation of the defendant to pay for said articles; that the defendant is about to remove his property or a material part thereof out of the State not leaving sufficient therein to satisfy ~~in~~ the plaintiffs claim or the claims of the defendant's creditors; that he has sold or disposed of his property or a material part thereof with the intent fraudulently to cheat hinder or delay his creditors; that he is about to sell or dispose of his property with the intent to cheat hinder or delay his creditors.

Wherefore ~~in~~ it prays judgment for \$74.50 with 6% interest from Feby 1, 1916, subject to a credit of \$1.00 paid March 9, 1917
