Plaintiff, says that it is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of Ky with power to contract and be contracted with and to sue and be sued; that the defendant by his written promisory note filed herewith marked not for identity, dated May 3, 1913 obligated and promised to pay this plaintiff on or before May 1, 1914 the sum of \$80.00 with interest from its date until paid, but that though said note is long past due he has paid no part thereof except the sum of \$17.00 paid May 7, 1914.

Wherefore it prays judgment for \$80.00 with 6% interest thereon from May 3, 1913 until paid with its costs subject to a credit of \$17.00 paid May 7, 1914, and all proper relief.
