

Tract 5. On the Warwick turnpike, beginning at a stone in said road where once stood a white oak corner to Lilliard and running thence N 64 E 9.50 chains to a stake, thence N 75 E 5.50 chains to a stone corner to Mrs. Jane Thompson, thence S 9 E 1.40 chains to a stone where once stood a red oak an original Dean corner standing in the East edge of the road, S 39 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 4.40 chains to an angle of the road, thence with center of the same S 85 W 11.10 chains to the beginning, containing 3 acres 1 rood and 38 poles.

Tract 6. Beginning at a stake in the Jackson pike corner to McCrosky thence with center of pike N 85 W 5.60 chains; thence S 77 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 1.5 chains; thence S 44 W 4.08 chains; thence S 75 W 2.10 chains; thence leaving the pike S 26 W 1.88 chains to a stone corner to Thompson, thence S 54 E 31.01 chains to a stone corner to McCrosky, thence N 44 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 16 chains to the center of the pike, thence with the center of same N 54 W 20 $\frac{1}{2}$  chains to the beginning, containing 45 acres.

The first three tracts of said land were conveyed to Charles P. Thompson by the heirs of Samuel Thompson dated March 7, 1907 D.B. 76 p 328; the fourth tract of land was conveyed to Charles P. Thompson by Robert Turner March 7, 1907 D.B. 76 p 331; the fifth tract was conveyed to Charles P. Thompson by deed of H. N. McCrosky dated May 25, 1907 D.B. 77 p 97; the sixth tract was conveyed to Charles P. Thompson by the heirs of Samuel Thompson by deed dated Nov. 30, 1913, D.B. 87 p 103.

In addition to the above lands the said Charles P. Thompson probable owned additional small tracts thrown into and with the other lands the sources of title to which the plaintiffs do not know; they file as a part hereof copies of the title papers under which the said Charles P. Thompson owned and held title to said land.

They State that during his life time said Charles P. Thompson sold parcels of said land thus; to S. H. Jones and Hettie L. Bird by deed dated Dec. 24, 1913 8.506 acres beginning at a stone in original line near an ask corner to said Thompson and Jones thence N 88 W 17.42 chains
