Plaintiff, Joe Sanders, states that ~~on~~ the Feby term of this Court he recovered against the defendant a judgment for \$72.00 with 6% interest from Oct. 10, 1912, and \$9.40 costs which judgment is unsatisfied and in full force and effect; he states that on Feby 22, 1917 he had an execution duly issued on said judgment directed to the Sheriff of Washington County which county was the place of the residence of W. L. Darland at the time of the judgment, and at the time the suit was filed and he was served with process in Washington County in the suit in which said judgment was ~~not~~ rendered; that said execution came duly to the hands of the then Sheriff of Washington County for execution thereof and he returned the same on the 18th day of June 1917 endorsed in substance no property found

Wherefore he prays attachment and garnishment against the defendant W. L. Darland, that any property he may own be by him disclosed in this action and subjected to the payment of his said judgment and he prays generally for his costs and all proper and equitable relief.
