The Plaintiff , Jellico Clothing Manufacturing Company , states that it is a corporation , duly organized under the laws of the State of Tennessee , & as such duly authorized to contract & be contracted with & to sue & be sued & that its principal office & place of business , is at Jellico , Tenn .

Plaintiff states that it sold & delivered to defendant , T. H. Carter , at his instance & request , on the 27th day of March 1918 , goods & merchandise , to the amount & value of \$66; & for which defendant agreed & promised to pay this plaintiff the said sum of \$66. in 30 days thereafter & plaintiff says said account & claim has now been long past due & no part of same has ever been paid , though payment of same has been demanded of defendant & that plaintiff is entitled to interest on said account from the 27th of April 1918 , being the date said account was due & payable . Said account is filed herewith as part hereof .

Wherefore plaintiff prays judgment against the defendant for the sum \$66. & interest from the 27th day of April 1918 , at the rate of 6% per annum until paid & for costs & for all proper relief ;
