The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff, Constable, Jailer, Marshal, or Policeman in the State of Kentucky:

It appearing that there are reasonable grounds for believing that _____

R. E. Dean

has committed the offense of

*Taking property not his own without
a felonious intent*

You are therefore commanded to arrest said *R. E. Dean*
and bring *him* before me to be dealt with according to law.
