Comes the Plaintiffs, Jones Bros., complaining of the Defendant, O.R. Simmons and for cause of action state that there is due these plaintiffs from the defendant the sum of \$8.55 which they claim with interest from March 10th., 1923, on a bank check which the defendant signed and delivered to plaintiffs and by which defendant promised to pay plaintiffs the sum above mentioned. Payment of said check was duly demanded at said bank but defendant had no funds at said bank and the same was not paid.

Plaintiffs state that they have made demand upon defendant for payment of said check but he has refused and still refuses to pay said amount or any part of the same.

Wherefore, plaintiff asks judgment against defendant for the sum of \$8.55 for interest on said amount from March 10th., 1923 and for costs of this action and for all other relief to which they may appear to be entitled.
