The Parley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association is hereby notified that a few days ago, an execution was issued in the above styled case and levied on a 1/2 undivided interest in 9 acres of tobacco grown on the farm of Mr. H. R. Cassell. Mr. Cassell has a landlord's lien on this crop, but only for the money advanced in its cultivation and marketting and not for anything thingelse. He's claiming a lien for some old debts of Simons incurred the year of 1923 and for some other old claims. He has no lien for anything except what he furnished that went into this crop. We are going to controvert his landlord's lien as to amount and hereby notify you to not pay him anything out of Simon's part until the amount of his lien is determined by the court. Of course you've no right to pass upon this question, which can only be determined by the Court. So don't pay him anything out of Simon's part until this matter is settled by the court. Terhune's debt, interest, and costs is about \$75.00-
