Plaintiff says that this is an action for money due upon a contract; that it is just, due, and unpaid and that ought to recover thereon said amount with interest from date of said account which was in 1920, but that said defendant promised 2 or 3 months ago to pay said account.

He says that defendant has no property in this State subject to execution or not enough thereof to satisfy plaintiff's demand and that the collection of said demand will be endangered by delay in obtaining a judgment and a return of no property found to satisfy same.

Wherefore plaintiff prays for a judgment for \$15.20 and all the costs of this action and for all relief to which he is or may appear to be entitled including a general order of attachment against the property of the defendant.
