

The defendants Dowling Brothers, filed herein a general demurrer to the petition as amended and paragraphs submitted to the beginning, containing 20 acres, more or less, being the same land conveyed to the heirs of Walker Williams by deed of Elizabeth A. Davis dated 1877 recorded in D. B. 45 pages 562&c.

The Court adjudges that Ella Thomas owns a one-fifteenth interest in said lands subject to the lien above set out, and that Dowling Brothers own fourteen-fifteenths thereof undivided, and the funds arising from the sale thereof will be divided accordingly.
