D L Curry, Master Commissioner of Mercer Lovvint Court and Receiver in above case, comes and reports, that among the assets of the Curry Grocery Company, that has come to his hands are 4 notes, each dated 23 Nov 1903 - each payable to Curry Grocery Company, each signed by A L Curry - each note for \$500 - one due 5 months after date one due six months after date, one due ten months after date + one due eleven months after date. That on the back of one of said notes, but the one due 5 months after date, there was endorsed several credits ten in number, all amounting to the sum of \$298⁴⁰. All of said credits were endorsed on said note before said note came into the hands of said Receiver, that when said Receiver received said notes from the Curry Grocery Company, there was attached to said notes, six certificates of stock issued by A L Curry Grocery Company, each certificate dated 25th of May 1904, signed by A L Curry President and issued to A L Curry, each of said
