we the undersigned, commissioners appointed to view the road sought to be opened in this case, report that we have viewed the proposed right of way, and find that it is already a fenced lane, without any gates or obstructions of any kind on same; that it begins at a point on the Providence pike, near Thompson Cloyd's residence and runs North, a distance of about one mile to the County Dirt road leading from the State pike to the Old Rynearson Mill; that it runs over the lands and between the lands of Thompson Cloyd, J. M. Prather, Rankin Clemens, Lucy Rebb, and D. Brewer. We further report that as it is already fenced, no damage will result to the above lands owners; we think that the road ought to be established for the convenience of the public in general and that it ought to be free from gates.
