Comes Garnishee and states that on December 20th, 1923, J. W. Coyle, whose address is Harrodsburg, Ky., delivered to it 2165 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #134473, on which was advanced the sum of \$177.18 to R. L. Black, to apply on landlord's lien.

On February 5th, 1924, said Coyle delivered 3658 pounds of tobacco of the 1923 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #135991, on which was advanced the sum of \$188.40 to R. L. Black, to apply on landlord's lien.

Said tobacco is subject to a landlord's lien in favor of R. L. Black, Harrodsburg, Ky., for \$534.42 as balance due, subject to a credit of \$189.45 paid to R. L. Black by Garnishee under distribution accruing under said certificates on June 1st, 1925.

The answer follows:

Garnishee states further that J. W. Coyle, whose address is Harrodsburg, Ky., delivered to it on December 23rd, 1924, 250 pounds of tobacco of the 1924 crop, for which was issued participation certificate #50253, on which was advanced the sum of \$25.97 to J. W. Coyle.

On January 7th, 1925, certificate #59253 was assigned to Mercer National Bank, Harrodsburg, Ky., for "ALL".
