Plaintiff is entitled to the immediate possession of said property and to \$2.50 damages for its retention by her.

Wherefore plaintiff asks for a judgment against the defendant for a return of this property if it can be returned and if not for a judgment for \$12.00 as the value of said table and all the costs of this action and for an order of delivery for said table and other relief to which she is or may appear to be entitled.
