

The Commonwealth of Kentucky,

To the Sheriff or any Constable of Mercer County:

Whereas Rhomas Johnson hath made complaint to me as Judge of the Mercer County Court, that Wallace W. Adams did on the 4th day of August 1914 1914, forcibly detain from the said Thomas Johnson a house, yard, garden, barn located in the farm of the said Johnson on Oak Ridge Pike in Mercer County, Kentucky,

~~which was in the peaceful possession of said~~ Thomas Johnson ~~which the said~~ Wallace W. Adams, tenant of the said Johnson now holds against him

You are therefore commanded to summon the said Wallace W. Adams to appear at the Court House in Harrodsburg, Ky., to answer on the 8th day of Aug, 1914, the charge of forcible detainer aforesaid, and give to the said Wallace W. Adams at least three days' notice of the time and place of the trial, and have then and there this writ.
