The plaintiff Harrodsburg Implement Company states that the defendants G C Parker and James Parker by their promissory note dated March 1st 1921, agreed and promised on or before the 1st day of Sept 1921 to pay to the plaintiff \$150.00 with interest thereon from date, no part of which has ever been paid except, \$25.<sup>60</sup> paid June 2nd 1922, and \$80. paid May 12th 1924. A copy of said note is filed herewith as part hereof.

Wherefore it prays judgment against the defendants for the said sum of \$150.00 with interest from Mch 1st 1921, subject to the credits aforesaid, and for its cost and for all proper relief.
