

BROOD SOWS.

Several weeks before brood sows become pregnant they should be given two light force feeds of MoorMan's Hog Remedy. Keep all fed away from them for about 24 hours, or long enough to make them hungry; then give them two lbs. of the Remedy mixed thoroughly with dampened oats, stop or dampened mill feed, to each ten head. Repeat same in 12 hours. Then put MoorMan's Hog Remedy before them and be sure they eat enough of it in the pure state in the self-feeder to keep their bowels open until they become pregnant. This, any man will find a help in getting a better breeding for healthy hogs.

After the sow is pregnant either mix equal parts of MoorMan's Hog Remedy with salt, or something else to reduce its strength and let them run to this mixture until the pigs are farrowed or give them a small amount in their feed every two or three days. Be sure to give enough to keep the bowels open. When the pigs are farrowed put the remedy at once before the brood sows in the pure state in the self-feeder and see that they eat enough of it to keep their bowels open.

We have never known pigs to have White Scours when MoorMan's Hog Remedy has been properly fed to the brood sows during
