McCampbell, and for answer herein, states that she is a housekeeper with a family residing in this Commonwealth and as such housekeeper is entitled to certain exemptions of personal property, under section 1697 of Kentucky Statutes. She states that she has several head of cattle, which are under mortgage; but she is compelled to feed and care for the same that is entitled to forage therefor, ^{or money in lieu thereof} and that she is entitled to sustenance, including breakfast and animal food sufficient for herself and family of than for one year; all of which should be set apart to her out of the proceeds of the property and cash attached herein.
