The Farmers Bank of Salvisa, Kentucky in liquidation sueing by James P. Lewis State Banking Commissioner and F. P. James Special Deputy Banking Commissioner in charge, states that on May 6, 1921 the defendant Davis Ashford executed and delivered to the Plaintiff his promisory note of that date by which he promised and agreed to pay it six months thereafter the sum of One Hundred Twenty and 75/100th dollars \$120.75 with interest thereon from date until paid; that no part of said note or interest has ever been paid; that said note is long past due.

Wherefore the plaintiff prays judgment against the defendant for \$120.75 with 6% interest thereon from May 6, 1921 until paid, costs and all proper relief.
