The Court being advised, is of opinion and so finds and adjudges that the tobacco raised by Sam Turner in the year 1922 and by him delivered to the garnishee Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association under P.C. 119781 and 51203, and the funds and proceeds from the sale of said tobacco now in the hands of the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association or in the hands of State Bank & Trust Co of Harrodsburg, Ky or which may hereafter come into their hands is owned and held as to title and ownership thus:-

(1st) State Bank & Trust Co first lien for \$175.00 with 6% interest from Jan 1, 1923 and \$309.00 with 6% interest from Jan 1, 1923.

(2nd) All of the remainder of said funds and proceeds ~~xxx~~ is the property of the defendant W. D. Sparrow.

It is ordered and adjudged by the Court that said Association and said Bank will disburse and pay out the proceeds and funds from said tobacco according to the terms of this judgment, and when they have done so they will be released as garnishees and from liability ~~xxxxxxxxxxxx~~ for said funds and will recover their costs. The defendant W. D. Sparrow will recover of Plaintiff his costs. This judgment covers the whole of the 1922 tobacco crop of Sam Turner and the numbers above are given for assistance in identity only.
